



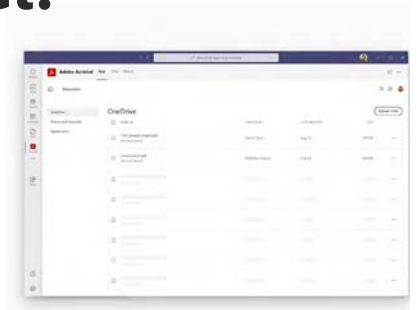

# Manage PDFs in Microsoft Teams with Adobe Acrobat.

- **Share and review** PDFs in Teams directly
- **Collaborate** in real time by commenting and annotating in Teams
- **Get notification of comments** made to PDFs directly in Teams
- **Access PDFs** stored in Microsoft SharePoint and OneDrive in Teams

Adobe Acrobat for Teams can now be the way your organization reads and works with PDFs in Teams. Ask your Teams admin to [enable Acrobat](#) so you can access free features such as adding comments, including sticky notes, highlights, and drawings. Additionally, by signing in to your Acrobat Standard or Acrobat Pro account, you can now combine, protect, export, organize, and protect PDFs in Teams.
